Knightsia excelsa - (Rewarewa)	Evergreen tree that can reach heights of 15-25m. Thrives in full sun to partial shade and prefers well-draining soils that are fertile and rich in organic matter. It can tolerate a range of soil types, including sandy, loamy, and clay soils. It can tolerate coastal conditions but may be sensitive to severe frosts. Chionochloa flavicans - (Miniature Toe Toe)	Long, slender grass which is usually silvery or bluish-green in colour, which may reach the height of 1-2m. Muehlenbeckia - (Pohuehue)	Versatile and attractive evergreen vigorous vine, which is excellent for erosion control. Thrives in full sun to partial shade, prefers well-draining soil types, It can also tolerate slightly acidic to slightly alkaline soil pH levels. relatively drought-tolerant. Can tolerate light frosts but may require protection in colder regions with harsh winters. The flowers and berries are a great attractant to birds and bees.
